Engage with Nature-Based Solutions provides FREE educational plans about BC Urban Streams & Watersheds. Lesson activities include creating puppets of the salmon life cycle, on-location nature journaling, and designing solutions using biomimicry.

Earlier grades explore the topics through our keystone salmon and other aquatic species, providing an engaging way to connect students to their local watersheds. Later grades explore local case studies, and apply their knowledge to global scenarios and the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals. Students collaboratively connect Indigenous perspectives and ways of knowing to scientific evidence, as they contribute to finding solutions to local watershed issues.

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
